

Sam Moore Consolidates Executive Functions, Re-Aligns Cost Structure

Bedford, Va., May 28, 2009: Sam Moore is consolidating executive functions and reducing its cost and overhead structure in a move to increase efficiencies and competitiveness.

Cole added that the new reporting structure will help us to be "totally focused on service and quality, to speed up our customer response time and delivery times."
